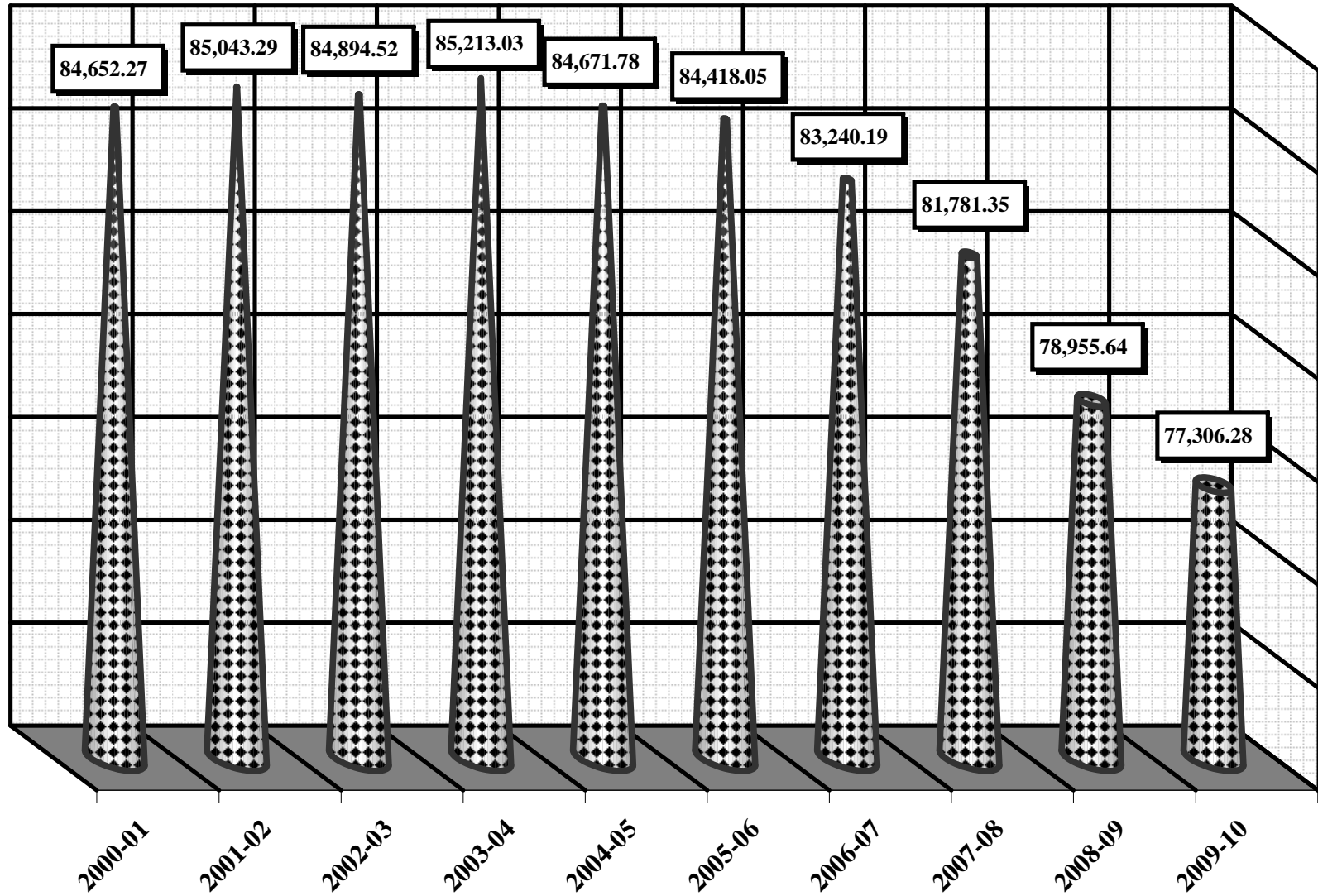

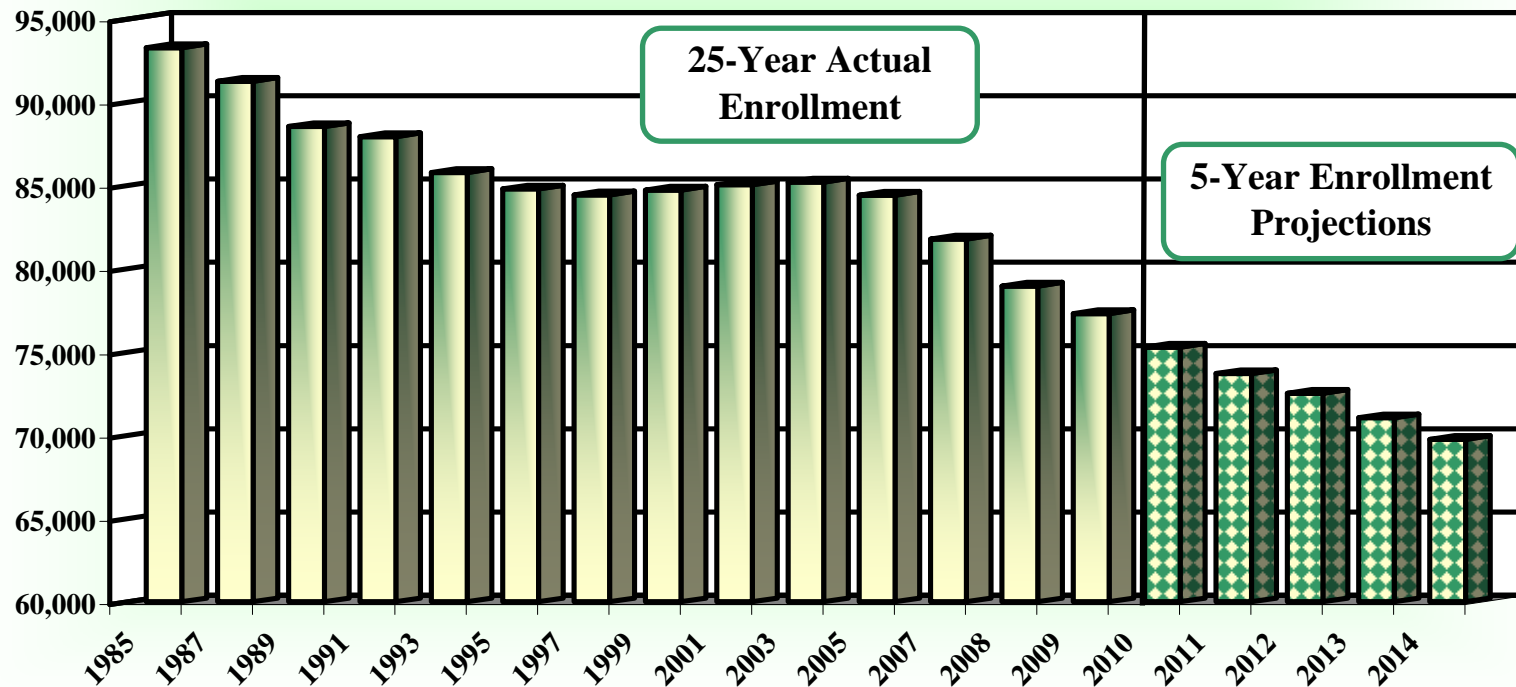

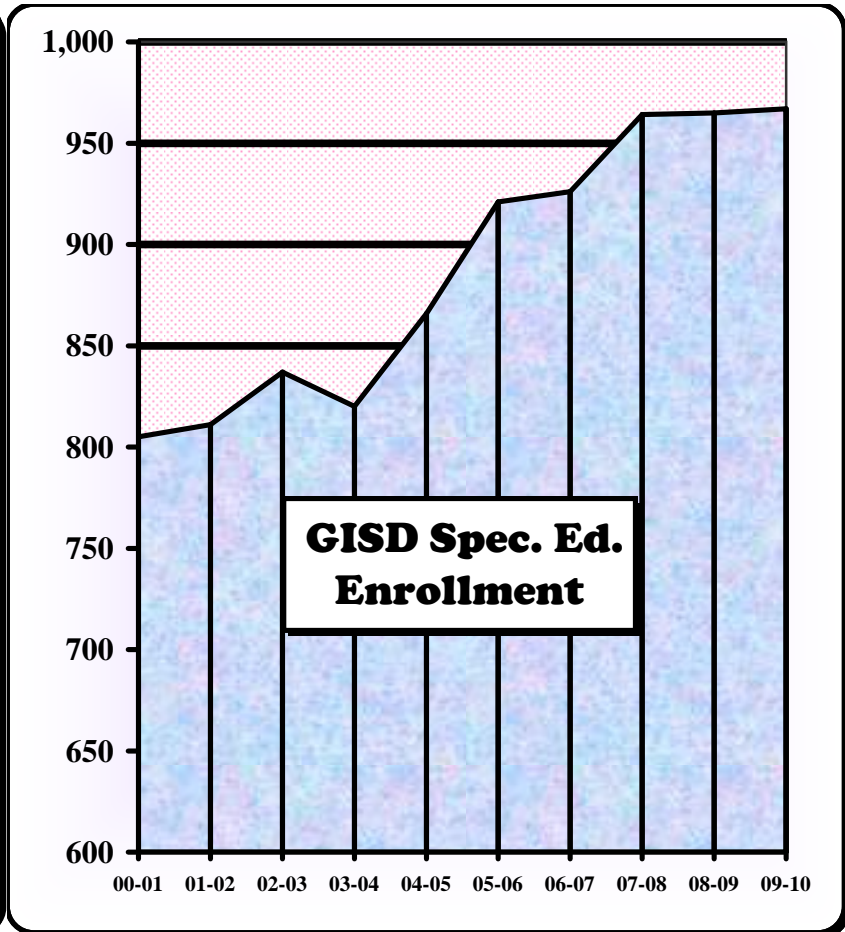
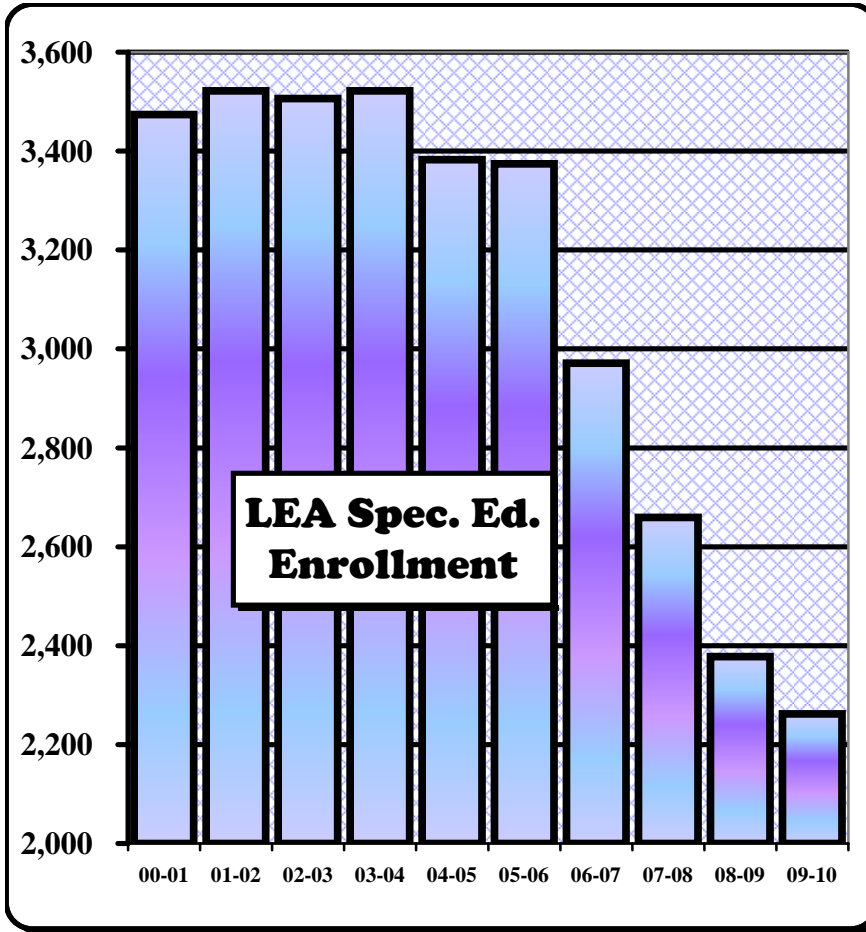
ADULT & ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION ENROLLMENT

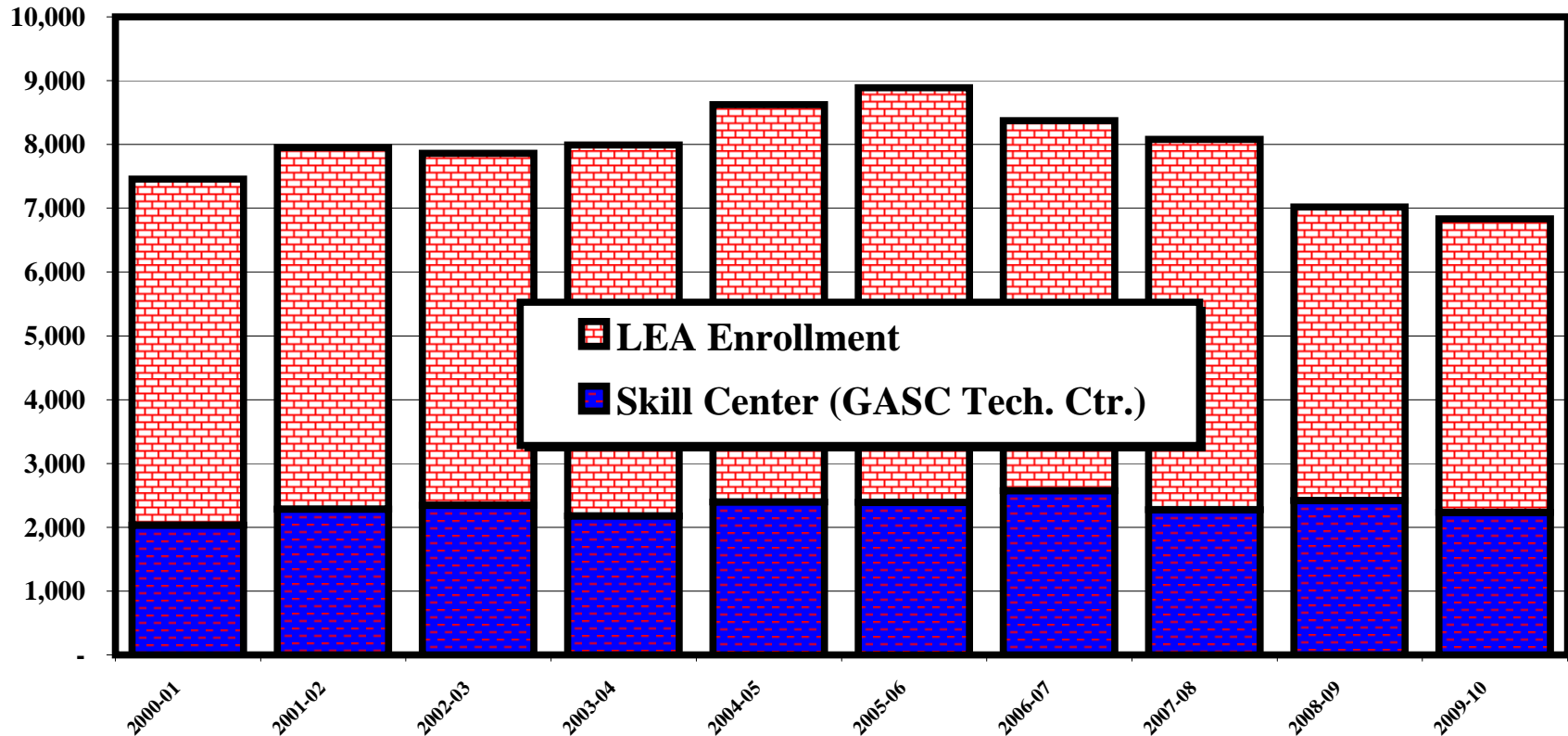

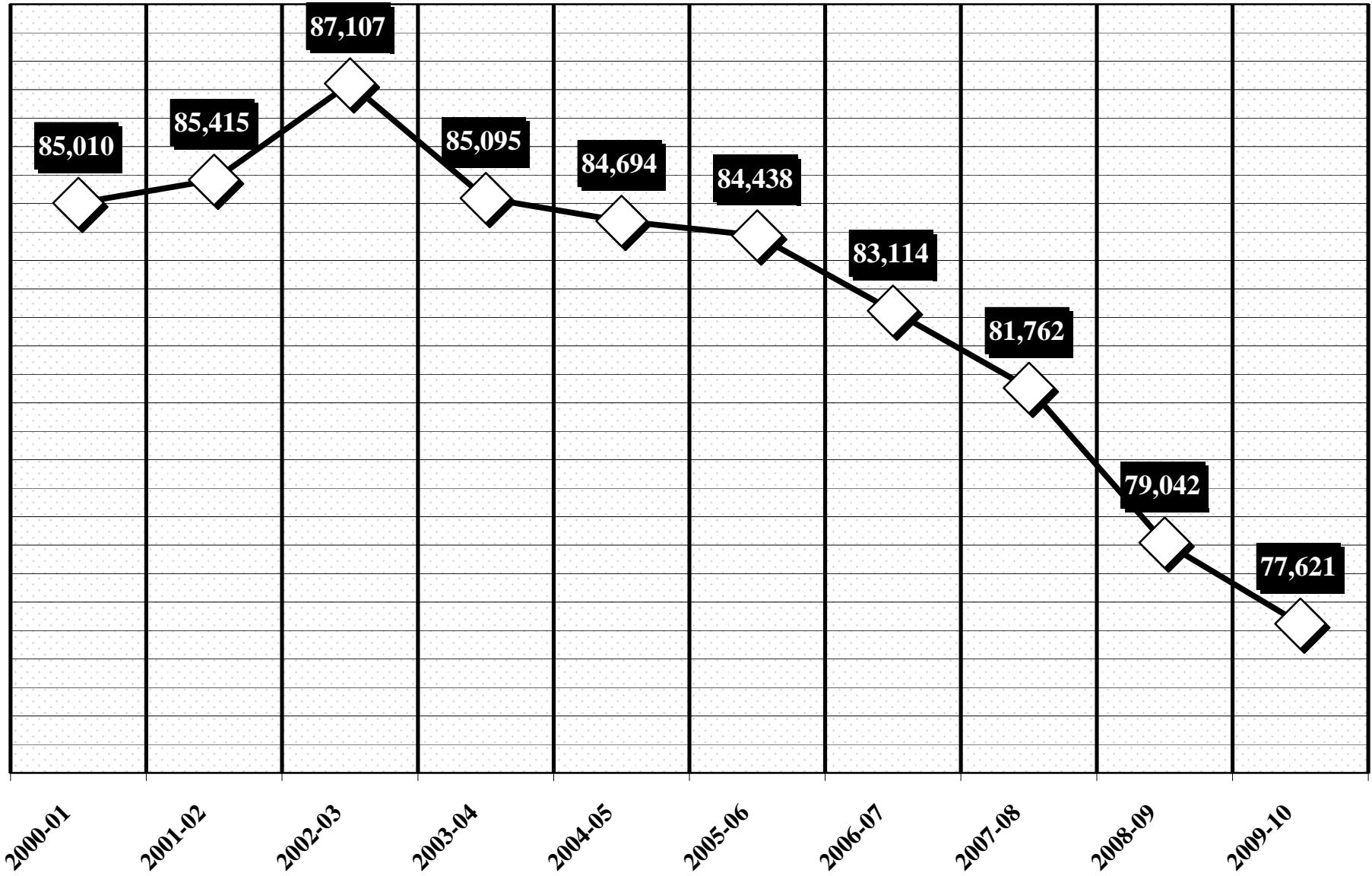

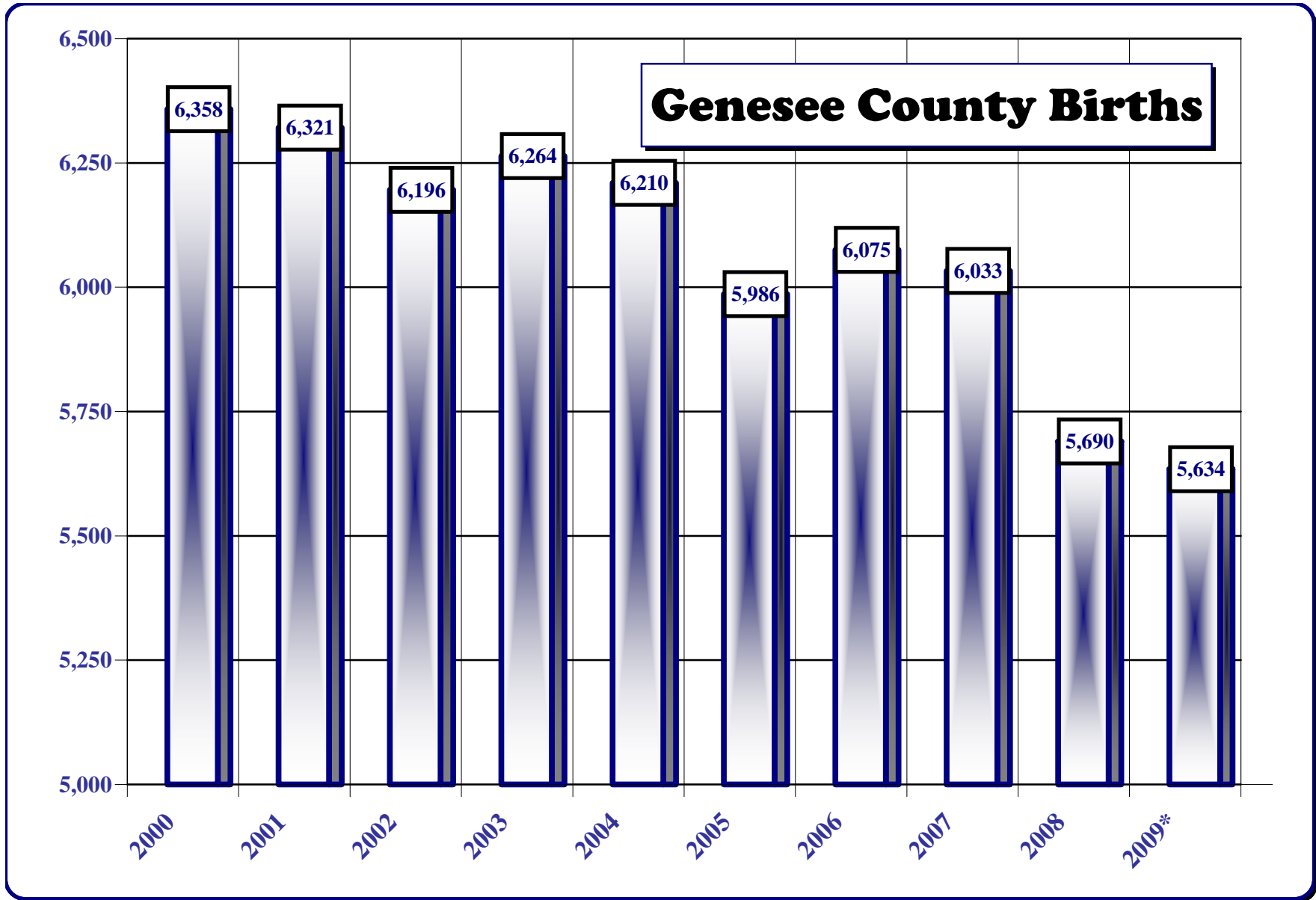

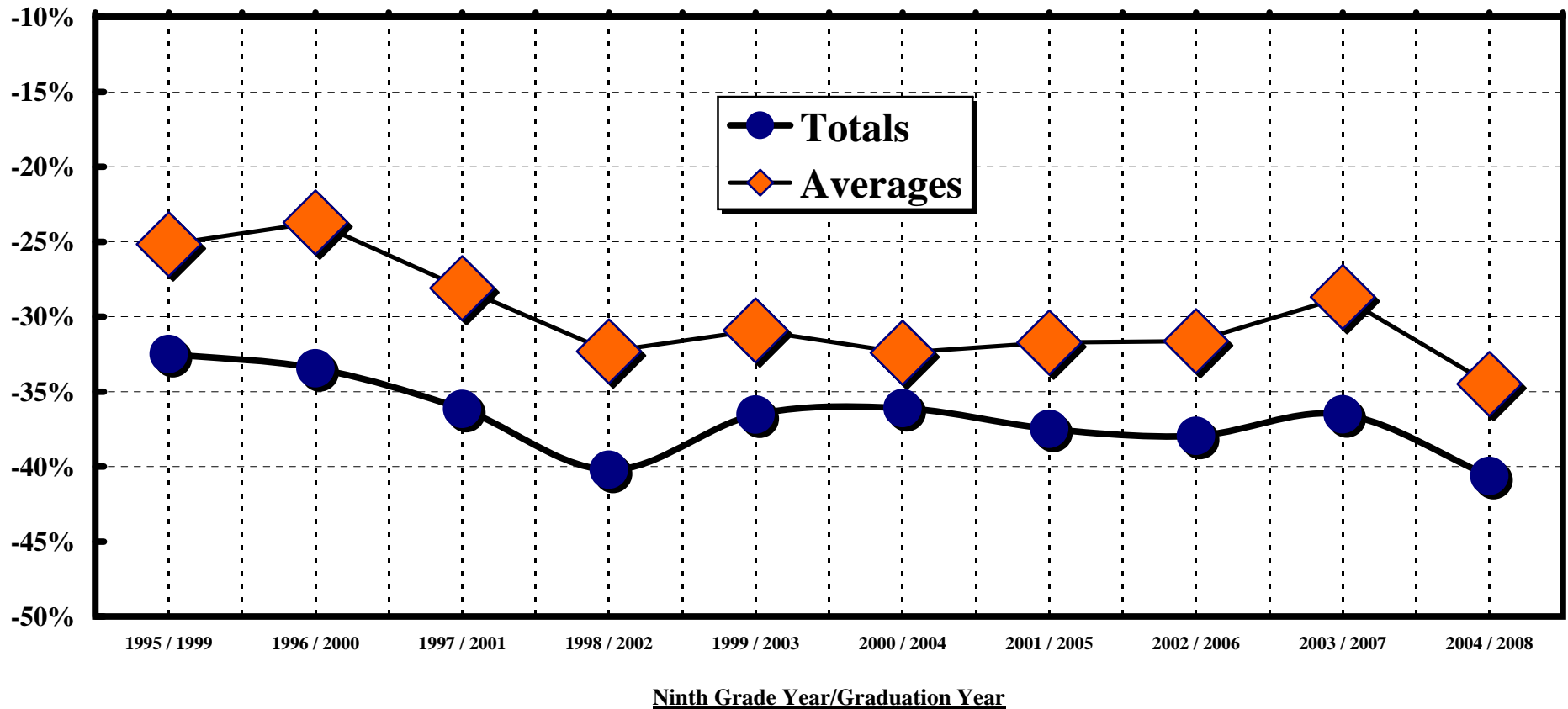
