

Notice of Calendar Changes for Genesee Intermediate School District Special Education Programs

GISD closed school for a total of 11 days this school year due to dangerous road conditions and severe cold temperatures. The State School Aid Act, Section 101(4) allows the first six (6) days cancelled for conditions not within the control of the school district. In addition, the state (with the approval of the Michigan Department of Education Superintendent of Public Instruction) has the ability to grant up to three (3) additional days to a district due to unusual or extenuating circumstances not within the control of school authorities.
